They continued their training at the "Musikhochschule" in Basel and the "Hochschule für musik Hans Eisler" in Berlin, where they were given classes from professors such as Claudio Martínez Méñher, Pierre Reach, Jonathan Aner, Wayne Foster-Schmidt, Artemis Quartet, Markus Becker, Natasha Prishpenko, among others.

Throughout their careers, they have won awards such as the 3rd prize in the 2017 Josep Mirabent i Magrans contest, 1st prize in the 2014 Capellades contest, 1st prize in the 2014 Barcelona Corts contest and the special public prize, 1st prize in the " Antón García Abril contest " in 2015, 1st prize in the national contest "Ciudad de Xàtiva" and 1st prize in the national contest "Ciudad de Albacete" in 2016, 2nd prize to the 13th BBVA prize "Montserrat Alavèdra", the contest "Mí Primer Auditorio" of the Più Mosso Foundation or the "International Chamber Music Competition Pinerolo y Torino città Metropolitana", among others...
